RESURRECTION WINDOW

Installed September 22, 2011.

A keyboard across the bottom of the window presents the designs central theme of music. Organ pipes on either side support the theme.

A 'ribbon' of colour symbolizes joyous music and singing rising towards the heavens in celebration of Christ's resurrection.

A cross forms a focal point in the design to represent the resurrection of Christ. It's ends are red to symbolize the sacrifice made by Him. Light radiates down from it's centre toward the green earth below.

Three stars in the heavens represent the trinity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The window is dedicated "to the Glory of God and in loving memory of all who in praise of His name have raised their voices in this sanctuary".

The two windows are companions and, considered together, honour mother and Son.
