

WINDOWS #706 & 707

Installed in
1984.

“The pre-existing pair of windows featuring Christ with St. Andrew and St. Peter was relocated to the center of the bank of six windows and the new windows flank these on both sides”.



In the original four windows,

Keys: a pair of keys symbolizes St. Peter, to whom Jesus gave the keys to the kingdom of heaven.

St. Andrew's cross: an X shaped cross is symbolic of the crucifixion of St. Andrew.

Shells: most often used to signify pilgrimage.

Chalice: a chalice represents communion and the forgiveness of sin. The chalice with a serpent is the attribute of St John the Evangelist.
