“The next pair of windows is the generous donation of the Melville family, long-time members of St. Andrew’s (Terry Melville’s father was

once rector of this

same church).

In the medallion of the left window, Christ is presented as teacher with the scripture: “And He went through the cities and villages teaching” (Luke 13:22). This serves also to commemorate Terry’s long career as a teacher. And, in the right window, the medallion presents Christ as healer with the scripture: “Power came out from Him and healed all of them” (Luke 6:19). This serves to commemorate Rene Melville’s long career in nursing. At the bottom of the windows, a maple leaf symbolizes Terry’s Canadian birth and a shamrock that of Rene’s Irish roots. The number fifty, in roman numerals, is shared across the two windows to commemorate the golden anniversary of their wedding and the daffodils symbolize the four daughters who have blessed their lives. The dedication across the windows reads: “To the Glory of God and celebrating family, anniversaries, and a lifetime of worship at St. Andrew’s”.
