“The third new pair of windows is kindly presented to St. Andrew’s by Ted and Penny Livingstone. The left medallion depicts three Greeks and their request to St. Philip: “Sir, we wish to see Jesus” (John 12:21). The right medallion offers Christ’s response to St. Philip and St. Andrew: “The hour has come for the son of man to be glorified” (John 12:23). Symbols at the bottom offer a pair of maple leafs representing the Canadian roots of both Ted and Penny and a single daffodil, and a pair of tulips, to represent their daughter and two sons. A black labrador retriever is also included to celebrate the love and companionship shared with the four legged members of their family. The dedication across the windows reads: “To the Glory of God and in celebration of joint ministry of saints . . . past, present, and future”.
