

# KEITH TUCKER MEMORIAL 2017 BURSARY

## ST. ANDREW'S ANGLICAN CHURCH, SIDNEY

### **Criteria**

This Bursary was established by the Parish Council of St. Andrew's Church, Sidney, BC, in loving memory of Keith Tucker in recognition of the many years of service to the Anglican Church of Canada.

### **Objectives**

#### Mission Statement

To know, proclaim and become living examples of Christ.

#### Our Stewardship Statement

God created us and therefore all of our resources belong to Him, just as we do.

One of our first tasks as Christians is to use God's resources rightly. These resources are to be shared between His service and our needs. It is important that we set aside a definite portion, a tithe, of God's resources for His work here on earth. The giving of our time, talent, and treasure is a tangible reflection of our growing faith in God and our relationship with Him.

### **Suggested Guidelines**

Applicant must be an active member of St. Andrew's Anglican Church, Sidney, BC. Where a question arises over a person's membership in the parish, the Rector and the Wardens will make the determination. The applicant must be a legal resident in Canada. The applicant must be completing his or her final year of high school and must use the Bursary proceeds within 18 months of the presentation date (i.e. July 1, 2017 to December 31, 2018). The applicant must show a commitment to serve his or her church and community. The applicant must be entering a recognized course at a post-secondary institute -i.e. University, Technical or Community College.

There is a total of \$1,500 available each year from this Bursary. If there are multiple, successful applicants the amount available will be divided equally.

### **Candidates will be evaluated on the following:**

- Applicant's letter on the importance of service in his or her life.
- Importance of the Anglican Church in his or her life.
- References from their Parish Priest or Deacon.
- Reference from the outside community, i.e. principal, counsellor, teacher or employer.
- References should be sealed by the writer and not opened by the applicant.
- Service/volunteer involvement – in the Parish and in the community.
- Scholastic achievements.
- Additional information such as: interests, hobbies, life and career aspirations.
